Sustainability Efforts

- Limited the number of printed Annual Reports

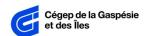

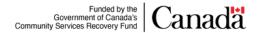

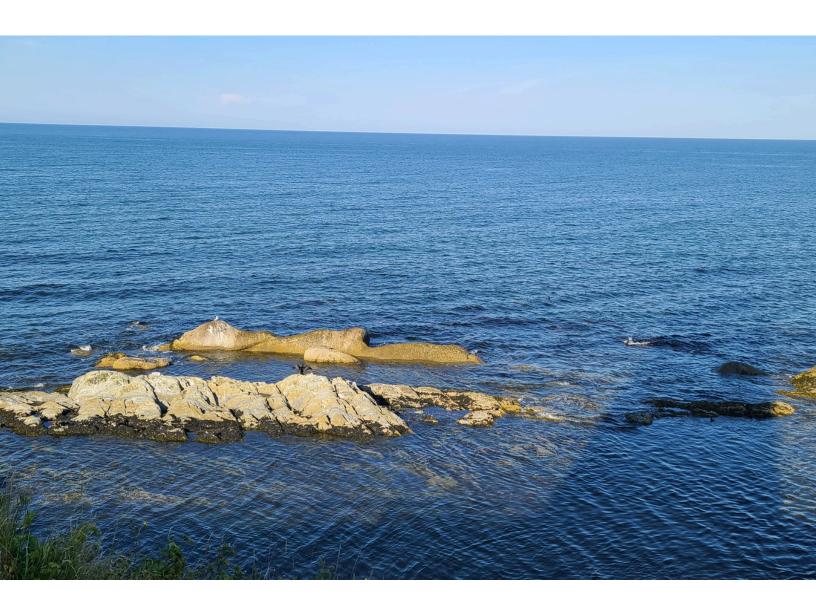
