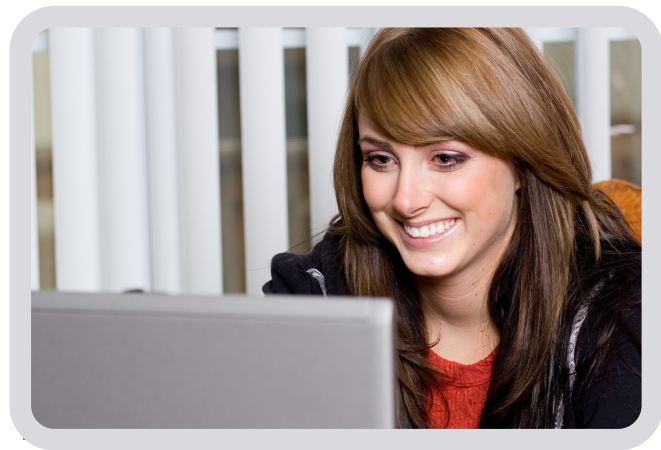


Digital Transformation: How the GLC is going Digital



The GLC has been hard at work putting our programs and activities online. One of our main goals over the past two years is developing a tutoring program and when the COVID-19 pandemic hit in the spring of 2020, we had to adapt – and quickly! This meant changing our way of reaching and helping both students and tutors.

Our organization focuses on providing tutoring services tailored to individual learners' needs in an understanding and supportive environment.
